

MURPHY FOR SCHOOL COMMITTEE CAMPAIGN COMPLETES ATTLEBORO LUNCH TOUR; GIVES OUT PENS

On Saturday, October 22^{nd} the David Murphy for School Committee campaign hosted an Attleboro lunch tour blitz, picking up take-out orders at six different Attleboro lunch spots and distributing literature and campaign pens to patrons at each establishment within an hour.

The Attleboro staples that were infiltrated by campaign volunteers included Mediterranean Grill in South Attleboro, Wetherlaine's and Tex Barry's on County Street, Morin's in downtown, Bliss Bros., and finally campaign flagship Briggs Corner Pizzeria. Each campaign volunteer participating in the "guerrilla lunch tour" picked up a take-out order at one of the respective institutions. Upon entering the establishment volunteers wearing Murphy for School Committee t-shirts distributed campaign pens and brochures discussing Murphy's biography as a former Attleboro High School student government president and graduate of Boston College Law School to unsuspecting patrons and servers.

"The lunch blitz was a fun way for my friends who are helping me with the campaign pick up a bite to eat while also giving me the chance to distribute information to voters, albeit by briefly interrupting their meal," Murphy said. "I am grateful to the establishments and their customers for letting us drop in for a few minutes."

Murphy said his only regret was that he picked up his take out order first and as a result it was quite cold by the time the group reached their final destination.
